5.	MINIMUM ENTRIES						
5.1	6 is the minimum number of pre entries which must be received for each Class and/or Division.						
5.2	If insufficient entries are received for a 4SS Class and/or Division to form in its own right, that 4SS Competition Class WILL NOT run. Discretionary Competition Classes may be Consolidated in accordance with the Rules or cancelled at the discretion of the Organiser and in accordance with the Rules.						
5.3	If a Class or Division is cancelled, the Entry Fee may be refunded at the discretion of the Organiser and in accordance with the Rules.

3.	KART RETRIEVAL
3.1.	Pit Crew with trolleys will not be given access to the Circuit during Practice, Qualifying or Racing.
3.2.	Retrieval of Karts is at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course
3.3.	Pit Crew must only enter the Circuit when permitted by the Clerk of Course or the Grid Marshal and then only if wearing a HIGH VISIBILITY SAFETY VEST on the upper torso.
3.4.	Karts can be retrieved via the Out Grid
4.	ADDITIONAL VENUE REQUIREMENTS
4.1.	Subject to any applicable laws which may govern the access of animals, including but not limited to guide dogs, no animals are allowed anywhere within the facility.
4.2.	No dumping of Fuel or Tyres, please make own arrangements.
4.3.	No unlicensed driving of motor vehicles permitted at the Circuit.
4.4.	No motorised scooters, mini bikes, roller blading, skateboards and tricycles allowed at the complex during the entire Meeting. Officials may confiscate any such items for the duration of the Meeting.
4.5.	Marquees are not to be erected without consent of the Club.
5.	TEMPORARY FACILITIES/STRUCTURES
5.1.	Your attention is drawn to General Rules Chapter 4 Rule 21 - Temporary Facilities/Structures Rules (the "TFS Rules")
5.2.	Type A Structures as detailed in the TFS Rules are permitted to be erected at this Meeting.

ONLY VIA PRIOR ARRANGEMENT WITH CLUB <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The Structure must be properly secured to the ground in accordance with the TFS Rules.
