4.3.	No unlicenced driving of motor vehicles permitted at the Circuit.
4.4.	No motorised scooters, mini bikes, roller blading, skateboards, bicycles and tricycles allowed at the complex during the entire Meeting. Officials may confiscate any such items for the duration of the Meeting.
4.5.	Marquees are not to be erected without consent of the Club.
4.6.	NO CAMPING ALLOWED IN THE VENUE
5.	TEMPORARY FACILITIES/STRUCTURES
5.1.	Your attention is drawn to General Rules Chapter 4 Rule 21 - Temporary Facilities/Structures Rules (the "TFS Rules")
5.2.	Type A Structures as detailed in the TFS Rules are permitted to be erected at this Meeting.
5.3.	 Type B Structures as detailed in the TFS Rules (i.e. with a floor plan between 18 sqm and 36sq) Will Not be permitted to be erected at this Meeting. The Structure must be properly secured to the ground in accordance with the TFS Rules.
5.4.	Unless specifically approved by the Organiser, Type C Structures Will Not be permitted to be erected at this Meeting.
5.5.	All Structures must only be erected in areas approved by the Organiser
5.6.	All Structures must be properly secured to the ground in accordance with the TFS Rules
