Video Recording Systems - Recording Medium (SD Card) Procedures

- a) It is compulsory for all Competitors to fit a camera to their Kart in a working condition from the start of the first practice session at this Meeting. Failure to do so will result in Disqualification of the Competitor from the next practice session. In the event of it being the final practice session of the day the Competitor will start from the rear of the grid in qualifying.
- b) A separate SD Card must be used for each Class contested at this Meeting.
- c) Prior to the commencement of on-track activity on each day of a Round, the Recording Medium used in the camera fitted to a Kart must be completely cleared and reformatted.
- d) No recorded vision on the Recording Medium may be deleted from the time that on-track activity has commenced on each day of a Meeting until 0700 hours the next day, without the prior written permission of the Stewards.
- It will be mandatory for each Kart competing to have a video recording system that is mounted in accordance with these Rules and be fully operational at all times while the Kart is on the Track: Technical Rules Chapter 1 Rule 8.

2.	KART RETRIEVAL
	Pit Crew with trolleys will not be given access to the Circuit during Qualifying and Racing.

	Pit Crew must only enter the Circuit when permitted by the Grid Marshal and then only if wearing a HIGH
2.2.	VISIBILITY SAFETY VEST on the upper torso.
2.3.	Karts can be retrieved via in/out grid -with the guidance of race officials
2.4.	Canteen will be operational all weekend.
3.	ADDITIONAL VENUE REQUIREMENTS
	Subject to any applicable laws which may govern the access of animals, including but not limited to guide dogs,
	no animals are allowed anywhere within the facility.

3.2.	No unlicenced driving of motor vehicles permitted at the Circuit.
3.3.	No motorised scooters, mini bikes, roller blading, skateboards and tricycles allowed at the complex during the
	entire Meeting. Officials may confiscate any such items for the duration of the Meeting.
3.4.	Marquees are not to be erected without consent of the Club.
3.5.	SERIES POINT SCORE
	The Series does publish Series point score updates after each round.
	a) A Driver must compete in a Class or Division at all six (6) Rounds of the Series to be eligible for overall Series Trophies.
	b) The Series classification in each Class or Division will be based on the Competitor with the highest accumulated points of all
	Rounds in the Series. For the avoidance of doubt, a competitor does not need to compete in all rounds of the Series to be
	eligible for the series awards.
	c) A Driver must compete in six (6) Rounds of the Series in any Class or Division to be eligible for the end of year lucky draw
	prizes.
	i) Lucky draw prizes must be claimed on the Saturday Night Draw at the final Round of the Series.
	ii) Drivers MUST be in attendance to claim prize.
	iii) In the event of there being unclaimed prizes after the initial prize draw, these prizes will be redrawn until all prizes have
	been claimed.
	The Series presentations will take place at the Karting Victoria Presentation night
