Minimum Entries

8 is the minimum number of pre-entries which must be received for each Class and/or Division.

If insufficient entries are received for a Class and/or Division to form in its own right, the **Compulsory Competition Classes will be Consolidated in accordance with Competition Rules – Chapter 1, Rule 9.**

Discretionary Competition Classes may be Consolidated in accordance with the Rules or Cancelled at the discretion of the Organiser and in accordance with the Rules.

If a Class or Division is cancelled, the Entry Fee will be refunded in accordance with the Rules.

Entry Details Confirmation

In lieu of an administration checking session, an Official Entry List including class, race numbers and transponder numbers will be posted on the Official Notice Board the afternoon of Thursday, 16 January 2025. It is the responsibility of the Competitor to ensure that all information on the Official Entry List is correct. Any inaccuracies or discrepancies are required to be notified to the Chief Timekeeper prior to the start of on-track Competition.

COMPETITION

Format of Racing

Practice	2 Practice session/s of 6 Minutes will be held.
Qualifying	There Will be Timed Qualifying at this Event. Qualifying grid positions will be determined by the 2 nd timed Practice session for Friday and Saturday. There will be one (1) standalone Qualifying session of 6 minutes on Friday 17 th & Saturday 18 th January.
<i>If Timed Qualifying occurs (Order of Karts on the grid must be random or determined from a Practice Session – no high/low numbers)</i>	
Races	Races 1 & 4: The grid will be determined by the results from the respective qualifying session with the fastest driver starting on position 1, 2 nd fastest on position 2 and so on. Races 2 & 5: The grid will be determined by the results from Races 1 & 4 respectively. Races 3 & 6: The grid will be determined by the combined points accumulated from Races 1 & 2 (Race 3) and Races 4 & 5 (Race 6). In the event of a tie-on points, the higher placing will be awarded to the driver who records the lower qualifying time on the respective day.

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Trophies and Prizes

401 points system will be used for all races.

0 points for non-starters and non-finishers.

Trophies will be awarded to 1st, 2nd and 3rd place in Race 3 and Race 6.

Overall trophies based on total accumulated points from all races (1-6) will be awarded to 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th and 5th place.

Prize money will be awarded to overall place getters as follows; 1st \$300, 2nd \$200, 3rd \$100, 4th \$75 and 5th \$50

Ladies Trophies will be awarded to the female Cadet driver and female Junior Driver with the highest accumulated points from all races (1-6).

In the event of a tie-on points, the higher placing will be awarded to the driver who recorded the higher placing (most points) in race 6.

Trackside Assistants

Allocation of Trackside Assistants Will occur for the Meeting for all classes in accordance with General Rules, Chapter 4, Rule 12.

The Trackside Assistants are required, when safe to do so, to assist any Driver to remove their kart/s from an unsafe position in the event of an on-track incident or breakdown. **Under no circumstances should a Trackside Assistant be filming or taking photographs during a Warm-up lap, Formation lap or the Race.**

Pit Crew/Participant Licence

Any persons who seek or require access to the circuit, the in grid, the out grid, scrutineering and parc ferme areas must hold either a current Pit Crew/Drivers licence or a Participation licence if the driver is a minor.

Protest Fees

Pit Paddock Allocation

Pit Paddock allocation Will Not occur for the Meeting.

Kart Retrieval

Pit Crew with trolleys Will Not be given access to the Circuit during Qualifying and Racing. If permitted, retrieval of Karts is at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course. Karts can be retrieved via In Grid

Temporary Facilities/Structures

All Structures must only be erected in areas approved by the Organiser in accordance with General Rules Chapter 4, Rules 21 (*the "TFS Rules"*)

All Structures must be properly secured to the ground in accordance with the TFS Rules

Type A Structures as detailed in the TFS Rules are permitted to be erected at this Meeting.

Type B Structures as detailed in the TFS Rules (*floor plan between 18 sqm and 36sq*) Will be permitted to be erected at this Meeting.

Type C Structures as detailed in the TFS Rules (*floor plan more than 36sq*) Will be permitted to be erected at this Meeting.
